#### **FY23 DRPT Grants Submitted**



Virginia Department of Rail and Public Transportation

CSPDC staff submitted FY 2023 DRPT grants on February 1, 2022. Grant applications were submitted for Urban and Rural Operating and Capital, and additional Demonstration Grant for Afton Express, the State match for the FTA 5339 application for the Staunton Lewis Street Hub rehabilitation, and Commuter Assistance Program Operating.

- → Due to the active shooter event at Bridgewater College, the BRCC Shuttles were unable to access Bridgewater stops during the afternoon of February 1.
- → Due to an accident on Route 42 and the subsequent blocked southbound lane, the BRCC Shuttles bypassed Bridgewater on February 4.
- → BRITE staff attended the FTA Region III Triennial Review Training Workshop held on February 9-11.
- → All BRITE routes operated their regular schedules on Presidents Day, February 21.
- → On February 25, BRITE staff participated in DRPT's Virginia Transit and Equity Modernization Study-Accessibility and Adequacy of Infrastructure Working Group meeting.
- → The BRITE Transit Facility monthly inspection was completed on February 25.

# Staunton Lewis Street Hub Rehabilitation Federal Grant Awarded



The Federal Transit Administration awarded CSPDC a \$1.2 million Bus and Bus Facilities Discretionary Grant to rehabilitate the BRITE Transit Hub on Lewis Street in Downtown Staunton.

- → The regularly scheduled BRITE Transit Advisory Committee meeting was held March 9.
- → Due to inclement weather, BRITE did not operate on March 12
- → Due to multiple vehicle accidents on I-81 and Route 11 on March 17, the BRCC Shuttle North was unable to complete its route for the 12PM hour. In the afternoon, traffic was backed up and resulted in delayed buses. The routes were altered to serve viable areas until traffic cleared up.
- → On March 18, BRITE celebrated Transit Operator Appreciation Day and gifted BRITE drivers with coffee gift cards and donuts.
- → The BRITE Transit Facility monthly inspection was completed on March 25.
- → BRITE staff attended the National Transit Institute's National Transit Database Workshop on March 28-31.
- → The Federal Mask Mandate that was set to expire March 18 was extended through April 18.

#### **Summer Trolley Hours Implemented**



Beginning May 2, the Staunton Downtown Trolley and Saturday Night Trolley will operate the following hours:

- Downtown Trolley: Monday-Friday, 10AM-9PM; Saturday, 10AM-6PM
- Saturday Night Trolley: Saturday, 6PM-10PM

- → CSPDC staff attended the Commonwealth Transportation Board (CTB) Spring Transportation Meeting on May 2 at Blue Ridge Community College.
- → Due to a road closure on Lewis Street at Baldwin Street on May 3, BRITE detoured buses around the area.
- → On May 4, BRITE ITS Phase I Kick-Off meeting was held with consultant Kimley Horn.
- → The regularly scheduled BRITE Transit Advisory Committee meeting was held on May 11.
- On May 12-13, due to JMU graduation and increased traffic, the BRCC Shuttle North did not serve the JMU Godwin Transit Center stop and instead stopped on Port Republic Road. With increased traffic, the bus faced delays.
- → The BRITE Transit Facility monthly inspection was completed on May 23.
- → On May 25, CSPDC staff participated in the DRPT Virginia Transit Equity & Modernization Study- Accessibility & Adequacy of Infrastructure Working Group meeting.
- → Due to roadwork on Florence Avenue on May 26, the Waynesboro Circulator was detoured off of Florence Avenue.
- → In observance of Memorial Day, BRITE bus routes did not operate, the only exception being the Staunton Downtown Trolley.
- $\rightarrow$  Due to mechanical issues, the BRCC Shuttle North was dealeyd on May 31.

# 2022 VTA Annual Conference & Bus Expo Hosted in Roanoke, VA



CSPDC staff attended the Virginia Transit Association Annual Conference at the Berguland Center and Hotel Roanoke. Sessions focused on: transit workforce; Virginia Transit Equity and Modernization study; microtransit; zero emission buses; and the Bipartisan Infrastructure Law.

- → CSPDC staff attended the Virginia Transit Association Conference in Roanoke, VA on June 1-2.
- → Due to weather and traffic delays, the BRCC Shuttles were delayed on June 8.
- → Due to paving around Shenandoah Avenue, the Waynesboro Circulator experienced some delays on June 9. The bus was unable to travel to Shenandoah Avenue and Social Services stops, but passengers were able to catch the bus at Delphine Ave/Bridge St.
- → On June 10, CSPDC staff attended the Transit Service Delivery Advisory Committee (TSDAC) meeting via videoconference.
- → Due to unforeseen circumstances, the Staunton Downtown Trolley ended service at 6PM on June 10- all stops were still covered through other routes except the Staunton Wharf.
- → The BRITE Transit Facility monthly inspection was completed on June 22.

- ightarrow Beginning July 5, 2021, BRITE Bus resumed fare collection on all routes again. Fare collection was suspended previously due to the pandemic.
- → The Afton Express Commuter Bus Service launched on September 1, 2021. Prior to the launch, a ribbon cutting was hosted to celebrate the service and recognize project partners.
- → A new bus shelter and bench were installed at Myers Corner in Fishersville.
- → BRITE again offered free rides on all BRITE routes for Election Day, November 2, 2021
- → The Federal Transit Administration (FTA) awarded CSPDC a \$1.2 million Bus and Bus Facilities Discretionary Grant to rehabilitate the Staunton Lewis Street Transit Hub in March.
- → On March 18, 2021, BRITE celebrated Transit Operator Appreciation Day and gifted BRITE drivers with coffee and gift cards.
- → As a result of a court order, as of April 18, 2021, the CDC January Order requiring face masks on public transportation hubs was no longer in effect.
- → CSPDC staff participated in the Virginia Transit Equity and Modernization Study conducted by DRPT. The study identified transit agency, rider, and stakeholder needs and developed an action plan to address those needs.
- → CSPDC began work on both the BRITE Transit Development Plan (TDP) and ITS Phase I- Mobile Data Collection System (MDCS).
- → BRITE was represented at a variety of outreach events throughout the year: Augusta Lions presentation; Waynesboro's Back-To-School Bash; MBU and BRCC orientation events; Waynesboro Rotary presentation; local Christmas parades.
