- → Due to forecasted inclement weather on January 25, BRITE delayed operations and service started at 12:30PM.
- → The Route 250 (Westbound) / Imperial Drive bus stop sign was installed and implemented in January.
- → Due to staffing shortages, the Staunton Downtown Trolley operated shortened hours on the following dates: January 5 and 16.

BRCC Schedule Change Pop-Up Events

- → Staunton Lewis Street Hub-- April 27
- → Due to unforeseen circumstances, there was a break in service for the Staunton Downtown Trolley- service resumed in the afternoon.
- ightarrow On April 21, staff completed the monthly transit facility inspection.
- → BRITE Transit Facility hosted the Virginia Community
 Transportation Association of Virginia's (CTAV) Paratransit
 Roadeo. The Paratransit Roadeo draws drivers from around
 the Commonwealth to compete on a course that tests skills on
 every level of the drivers' abilities, with a primary focus on safe
 operations and passenger safety.
- → Shop & Dine Out in Downtown Staunton resumed in April. The Staunton Downtown Trolley and Saturday Night Trolley will be detoured Friday at 4PM through Saturday to coincide with street closures.



North/West Loops Route Change Implemented



Beginning Monday, May 1, and moving forward, the North & West Loops route changed slightly to improve route safety. The West Loop was rerouted from Forest & 3rd Street, and the route now travels Hays and Grubert Avenues. Additionally, Gypsy Hill House is now the last stop on the West Loop instead of the first stop on the North Loop.

- → The route changes for the Staunton North & West Loops were implemented on May 1.
- → The Summer hours for the Staunton Downtown Trolley and Saturday Night Trolley were implemented on May 1.
- → On May 10, the regularly scheduled BRITE meeting was hosted at the CSPDC office.
- → Due to road closures and extra traffic for JMU graduation, the BRCC Shuttle detoured around the JMU campus May 10-12.
- → CSPDC staff completed the monthly transit facility inspection on May 19.
- → CSPDC staff attended the Virginia Transit Association (VTA) Conference and Expo in Virginia Beach May 23-24.
- → In observance of Memorial Day, only the Staunton Downtown Trolley operated on May 29- all other BRITE routes did NOT operate.
- → The draft BRITE Title VI Plan was released for public comment
- BRITE implemented new stops at the Augusta Health Outpatient Pavilion and Amazon (Fishersville).

- → The Value Engineering Workshop took place on June 14 for the Staunton Lewis St Hub Rehabiliation Project.
- → In observance of the Juneteenth holiday, Afton Express did not operate on June 19; all other BRITE routes operated as regularly scheduled.
- ightarrow On June 20, the CSPDC Board of Commissioners adopted the CSPDC/BRITE Title VI Plan.
- → BRITE & Afton Express offered fare-free rides on June 21 to celebrate DRPT's Discover Transit campaign.
- → Afton Express sponsored Waynesboro Parks & Recreation's Groovin' on the Greenway on June 29.
- → Due to a mechanical issue on July 1, the Staunton North & West Loops experienced a slight delay.
- → On July 3, due to road closures for 4th of July celebrations, the Staunton Downtown Trolley operated a modified route. Then, in observance of the 4th of July holiday, on the Downtown Trolley operated with a slight detour to accommodate increased traffic and road closures; all other routes did not operate.
- → Due to a mechanical issue on July 7, the 250 Connector (Eastbound) experienced a slight delay.
- → The BRITE Transit Advisory Committee (BTAC) hosted its regularly scheduled meeting on July 12.
- → Due to a mechanical issue on July 13, the BRCC South Shuttle experienced a delay.
- → CSPDC staff set up a table for BRITE and Afton Express services at Waynesboro's Back-To-School Bash at Kate Collins Middle School on July 30.

- ightarrow Afton Express celebrated one year of service September 1. Events were hosted throughout the month in conjunction with DRPT's Discover Transit campaign.
- → The BRITE Transit Development Plan was completed and adopted February 2023.
- → The FTA Triennial Review was due for the CSPDC in 2023. The process began in February with the completion of the Recipient Information Request, and was followed by the virtual site visit in July-August. The review culminated with only three findings, with corrective actions to be taken by year end.
- → To better align service with demand, the BRCC Shuttles hours of operation decreased in the evenings. Final schedule change revised operating hours to end at 5:30PM and 7PM instead of the previous 10:30PM and 11PM ending hours.
- → The CSPDC Title VI Plan was completed and adopted June 2023.
- → CSPDC continued work on the ITS-Mobile Data Collection System and Staunton Lewis Street Hub Rehabilitation projects.
- → September through January, VRT was faced with staffing shortages which led to abbreviated hours throughout that timeframe on the Staunton Downtown Trolley.
- → Throughout the fiscal year, route modifications were made to the Waynesboro Circulator, Stuarts Draft Link, and Staunton North & West Loops.

- → The Triennial Review virtual site visit was held from July 31-August 3.
- → The new revised schedule change for the BRCC Shuttles was implemented August 1.
- → CSPDC staff attended BRCC and MBU Welcome/Orientation Events to let students know about BRITE Bus routes.
- → To celebrate the second anniversary of Afton Express, fare free rides were offered on September 1 and a pop-up event was held on September 14 in Charlottesville.
- → In observance of Labor Day, only the Staunton Downtown Trolley and BRCC Shuttles operated; all other routes, including Afton Express, did not operate.
- → Starting September 5, and moving forward, the westbound 250 Connector Valley View Senior Apartments stop is now a fixed stop from 8A-12P and will remain a CALL stop the remainder of the day; and the Stuarts Draft Link will stop at Amazon (Fishersville) starting at 6:45A through 6:45P, which makes it the first and last stop along the route.
- → The BTAC hosted its regularly scheduled meeting on September 13.
- → CSPDC staff gave a BRITE Bus presentation to Valley Program for Aging Services (VPAS) and attended the ARC of Augusta's Disability Resource Fair in Waynesboro on September 19.
- → To celebrate DRPT's Discover Transit Initiative, BRITE and Afton Express operated fare-free on September 20, and hosted pop-up events on September 14 & 28 (Charlottesville & Staunton).
- → The monthly transit facility inspections were completed August 25 and September 25.
- → Delays/route modifications due to weather, mechanical issues, traffic/accidents/road closures, or unforeseen circumstances were experienced:
- August 7- All routes; August 11- Afton Express; August 29- 250 Connector (Eastbound);
